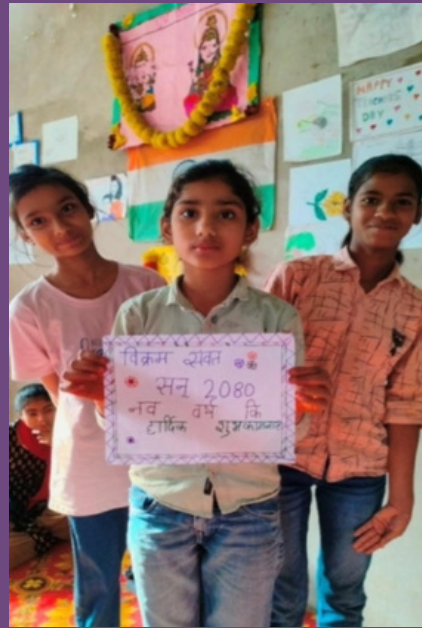

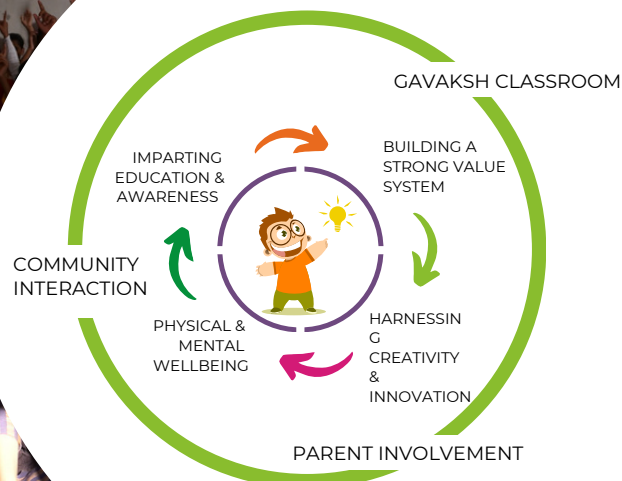

ME-TO-WE

5 DAYS-LONG "ME-TO-WE" WORKSHOP
WITH LAA PO LAA TIE INDIA
24TH -28TH MARCH 2023

Laa Po Laa TIE India organized a five-day Theatre In Education Workshop "Me-to-We" at Gavaksh Pathshala, Palwal, Haryana, led by Walter Peter, the founder of Laa Po Laa TIE – India.

Walter Peter, a multi-talented individual who is the founder of Laa Po Laa TIE – India, holds the India Book of Records, has spoken at TEDx, and has experience as an actor, theatre practitioner, facilitator, writer, director, and designer. We are honoured to have him as a guide for our students at GavaKsh.

The workshop included role plays, improvisations, and theatre exercises to enhance the participants' personalities and promote education, self-awareness, and effective communication for transformational change in society. The workshop was held from 24th March 2023 to 28th March 2023.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE WORKSHOP:

On Day 1 (24/03/23) of the workshop led by Laa Po Laa TIE – India at Gavaksh Pathshala, the session began with a prayer followed by an introduction to the Laa Po Laa organization and the objectives of the workshop. The day's activities included body-opening exercises, self-sketching, and discussions on the meaning and relevance of everyone's name. The participants engaged in various activities focused on gaining a new perspective, sharing their thoughts and likes/dislikes, and making new friends.

On Day 2 (25/03/23) of the workshop, the students at GavaKsh were engaged in various activities. First, they were asked to draw an image of an object that they themselves relate to or resemble with, such as a ball, butterfly, or camera, and write ten lines about it. Next, a drama was performed about the life of early humans. The children then participated in a group activity where they used their bodies to create shapes of houses, trees, and other objects. Lastly, a homework assignment was given where the kids had to write a rhyme or poem using the names of their family members.



On Day 3 (26/03/23) of the workshop, the students' self-portraits were displayed on a newspaper pasted on the wall, and they were asked to self-assess their sketches. They were also tasked with identifying the oldest item in their homes and drawing a sketch of it. In addition, a trust-building exercise was conducted. A Laa Po Laa cake was cut to celebrate the occasion.

On Day 4 (27/03/23), the participants began by recalling all the activities they had done so far and documenting them. They were then informed about their fundamental and constitutional rights, as well as the children's helpline number. In an effort to promote environmental awareness, the children created collages using waste material. The importance of education and the positive impact it can have on one's life was also emphasized.

On Day 5 (28/03/23), the workshop participants engaged in various activities. They started the day with a dance session, followed by group play and role play. Later, they did a group painting activity and learned about the importance of gender equality. To commemorate the event, everyone's handprints were taken on a white sheet.

CONCLUSION:

The main objective of conducting this workshop was to promote social harmony, develop cooperation and leadership skills, discover and utilize multiple intelligences in daily life, transform negative emotions into collaboration and love, raise awareness about gender equality and a peaceful society, and foster self-esteem and teamwork. The workshop concluded with participants sharing their experiences and learning with one another.

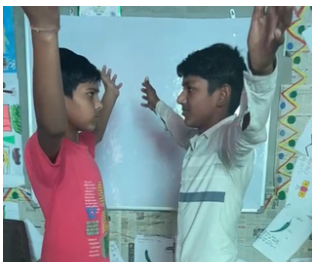

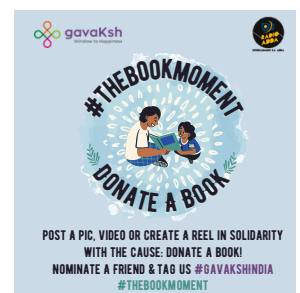
OPENING OF GAVAKSH PATHSHALA – LIKHI CENTRE

SPORTS WEEKEND

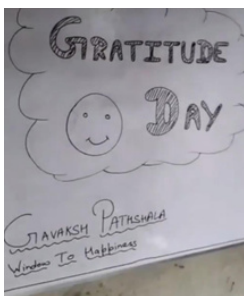
